Dear Tom,

This is to thank you for your letter of the 22nd January.

Trying to answer your query about golfclubs in this country I could not think of a better one than to send you the official directory for this country, which please find enclosed. I am afraid that if you want their scoring cards you will have to write to all of them separately.

I can save you the stamp for writing to my home club, the Kennemer, though. Enclosed please also find our scoring cards. Some explanation may be useful. The one that says White/Red Boxes is the Medal and Ladies' Medal card of the Orange Course (present Championship Course). The small cards for the Blue Boxes are the Championship Tees Men's (Blue) and Ladies' (Black) of the Orange course. The White Course cards are curio's. 9 holes are being added (the last four to be opened this year) and five of these and a small intermediate hole (1A) which is eliminated this year have been in use for some time. Later this year there will be a full nine holes card for the White Course and a new card will be made. Eventually the White course and 9 holes of the Orange course will be combined into a new championship and competition course, leaving the other 9 as extras.
