

Daar is baie lede in Amerika, net ek self alleen uit Suid Afrika, een in Australia, en 'n paar in Engeland.



(Editor's Note: If those who have been members of this aging Society will bear with it, we thought it might be a good idea to attach this page to our Directory so that newer members might learn of the background behind the formation of the group . . . and, also, to enable any member to solicit, through the use of the blank form below, other collectors who may wish to join us.)

The Golf Collector's Society came into being in September 1970 after discussion among several collectors who wondered if there might be good reason for the formation of such a Society so that we might get to know one another either through correspondence or actual meeting. A mailing was sent the collectors whom we knew or had heard about and the response was encouraging to the point that we did loosely organize the group.

We would emphasize, for the benefit of newer members and potential members, that the term "organize" is, indeed, used loosely . . . because there are none of the usual trappings of an organized club. No By-Laws . . . no officers . . . no dues . . . no rules and regulations that must be observed to either join or belong.

Our sole purpose is to get men together who share the fascination of collecting Golfiana . . . old clubs, books, balls, golfing prints and illustrations, scorecards, postcards, trophies, statuary and/or any other type of item that is associated with the great game of golf.

A modest Bulletin is circulated at the whim of the editor and an annual Directory of our members will be distributed.

Dear Stephen,



Dear Steven,

Enclosed now is your list of golf stamps, to complete the entire list. I believe these are all the golf stamps ever issued.

Enclosed also the Gary Player stamp and signed FDC, also the Gary Player Rose and FDC and Bophuthatswana stamps and FDC. This latter is one of the Black Independent States that have come about in this country by our Government presenting an ethnic nation with massive amounts of land so that they may develop independently. It is to the west of here. The Sun City Hotel is a resort complex and Player was asked to design and build the course, which was then named after him. (It is not Gary swinging on the stamp).

I have also sent you, by seamail, a book GHOLF SAAM MET DIE BOERE, the first and only book on golf in the Afrikaans language. I think you will have a lot of fun out of it.

Now what can you do for me? I have a number of foreign-language books, German, All four Scandinavian, Italian, Japanese, French, and have suddenly realised that I have none in Hollands! If there are any Dutch golf books (original Hollands, not translations), then I would be very pleased indeed to have them, if you can so organise. Anything additional to pay, I will do so, of course.

I enjoyed your latest research in the GCS Bulletin very much. Will you let me have a brochure or whatever of the golf exhibition you are working on?

GOLF STAMPS as listed in GOLF COLLECTORS' SOCIETY BULLETIN
No. 34, p. 9 totalled 24.

The subsequent issues were:

25. JERSEY, Feb. 28, 1978. 4 stamps honouring Harry Vardon.
26. ST. CHRISTOPHER, NEVIS, ANGUILLA, Sep. 8, 1978. Depicts Royal St. Kitts Hotel and Golf Course.
27. SOUTH AFRICA, Oct. 4, 1979. Four Rose stamps to mark the fourth World Rose Convention held in Pretoria. One rose is named "Gary Player".
28. GRENADA, Nov. 2, 1979. A series of nine stamps depicting Walt Disney Characters, to commemorate the Year of the Child. The 4c stamp shows Donald Duck swinging.
29. GREECE, Nov. 24, 1979. One of a series of nine stamps in honour of anniversaries and events. The golf stamp honours the 27th World Cup Tournament held at Glyfada Golf Course.
30. JAMAICA, Nov. 26, 1979. One of a series of four depicting various events and places in Jamaica.
31. CHRISTMAS ISLAND (Indian Ocean), Feb. 12, 1980. Two stamps to commemorate 25 years of golf on the island.
32. LUXEMBOURG, Apr. 28, 1980. Stamp promoting sport for health.
33. FRANCE, Oct. 20, 1980. Issued to honour the French Federation of golf.
34. BOPHUTHATSWANA, Dec. 6, 1980. Two stamps showing the Gary Player Country Club Golf Course at the Sun City Hotel.
35. COLOMBIA, 1980.

The United States of America will issue the first golf stamps in September 1981, honouring Bobby Jones and Mildred Zaharias.
