Dear Hank.

In reply to your letter about the Closed Championship, I have talked the matter over with our Committee. -

We have no objection in letting Amateurs play in that Competition, and I also believe it would make it very interesting.

The winner would be Closed Champion of Holland, being either Professional or Amateur. It is not possible to play for two titles in one match, so there could not be a Prof. Closed Ch. and an Amateur Closed Ch.

(Unnecessary to say that first prize ought to go to the leading Professional, as in the case he might not win the Championship, an Amateur being first.)

I hope you will agree to this, I spoke to Lambert about this matter and he quite agreed with me.

I trust the match will be a success and personally I am looking forward with great pleasure to this meeting.
